

## 2022 DRESSAGE WINNIPEG COMPETITION WAIVER

**THIS DOCUMENT WILL AFFECT YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND LIABILITIES. PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING.**

**NOTE: This waiver forms part of the entry form and is valid for this rider/horse /owner/person responsible / parent or guardian combination for the entire 2022 Dressage Winnipeg competition season. If any of the above parties change throughout the 2022 competition season, a new waiver must be signed.**

I hereby certify that every horse and rider is eligible as entered and agree for myself and my representatives to be bound by the Constitution and rules of Equestrian Canada and any other rules imposed by the competition at these competitions. It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I hereby accept this risk and hold harmless EC, MHC, the competition, their officials, organizers, agents, employees and their representatives. The person responsible (PR) agrees to the release of any information on the entry form to EC and further agrees that any photos taken of this horse/rider at Dressage Winnipeg competitions may be used publicly to promote Dressage Winnipeg as an organization, dressage as a sport or to assist in obtaining sponsorships.

(Section A, General Regulations-Glossary: Person Responsible) The Person Responsible for a horse must be an adult who has, or shares, responsibility for the care, training, custody and performance of the horse and who has official responsibility for that horse under EC Rules and is liable under the penalty provisions of the Rules for any violation of the EC Rules. For the purpose of these Rules, the Person Responsible is normally the trainer, owner or the competitor who rides the horse during an event, or a parent or legal guardian in the case of junior (legal minor) competitors. The Person Responsible is ultimately responsible for the condition, fitness and management of the horse and is alone responsible for any act performed in the stables by himself or herself or by any other person with authorized access to the horse, or while the horse is being ridden or exercised. The Person Responsible must hold a valid EC Sport License in good standing at the same level or higher in which the horse is competing. Junior (legal minor) competitors cannot be the Person Responsible. In the case of Junior (legal minor) owner entries the Person Responsible may be a parent/ guardian OR an EC Sport License holder of age of majority.
