## VOLUNTEER POSITIONS & DUTIES

<b>Position</b>	<b>Description</b>
Announcer	The announcer is responsible for making sure the show is moving along according to the schedule and making it more interesting for spectators. Before the test announce the test, name of rider and horse. After the test announce the name of the rider and horse, and possibly a few interesting details about their horse (breed, age etc). They will thank our sponsors, announce ring and lunch breaks, changes in order of go, scratches, and messages to riders or volunteers in the barn.
Gate Keeper	Removes section of the gate at letter "A" of the ring to allow rider to enter and replaces gate immediately. Upon salute at the end of the test, remove the gate to allow rider to exit the ring. Good for first timers, bring a lawn chair!
Scribe	The scribe sits with the Judge during all tests, and must have previous training or experience with scribing. They can quickly and neatly fill out test scores and jot down the judge's comments to aid the rider in further development. Experience can be obtained at a Scribing Clinic and volunteering at schooling shows.
Whipper-In	Directs riders from warm-up ring to show ring, right on time by the schedule. This position is provided with a 2-way radio to keep in contact with the show office for schedule changes and scratches.
Runner	Transports the dressage tests from all rings to the show office for scoring. May be needed to run other items around show grounds as necessary. Bring a lawn chair!
Test Scorer	Located in the Show Office, calculates the final score and percentages of all tests ridden. You may not score the test of a family member, student or coach; another person in the office can step in when a conflict arises.
Show setup	Assist Show Office staff with set up starting the day before warm ups.
Bingo	Assist as directed at the Casinos of Winnipeg. MHC awards bingos to DW at various times throughout the year. *Must be 18 years of age or older.
Overnight Security	Must camp over the weekend at the MHC site, responsible for night checks on all horses and be in contact with owners/vets in case of emergencies.
